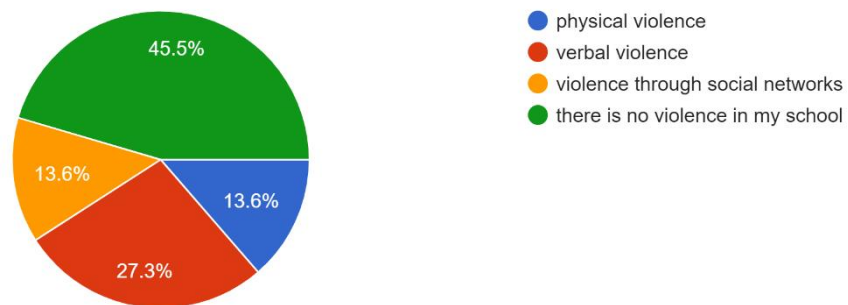

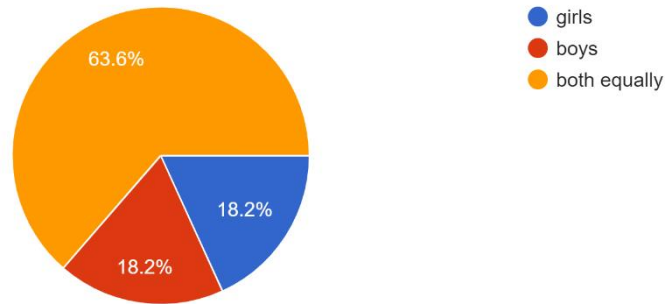
### 3. What form of violence is prevalent in your school?

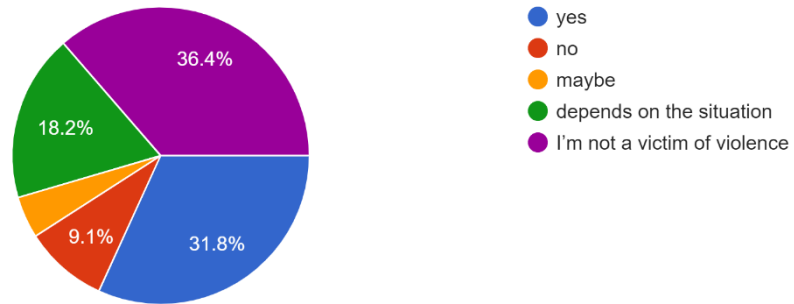

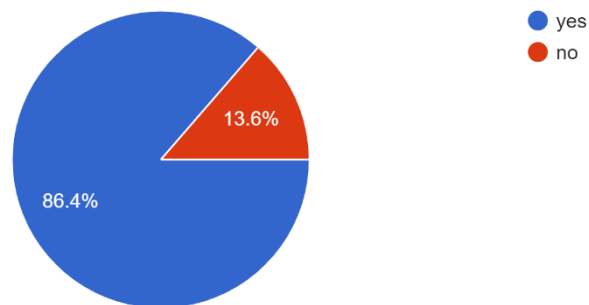

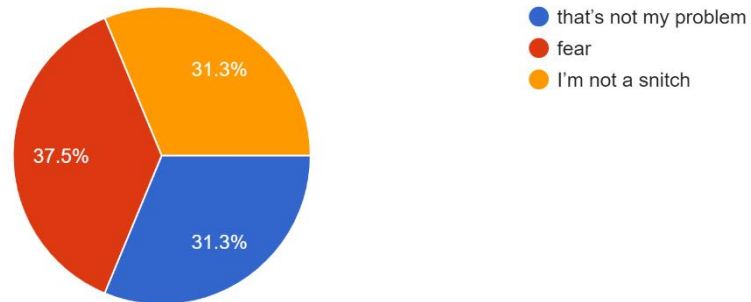

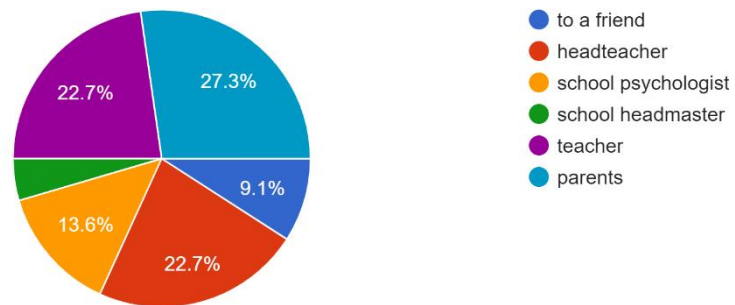

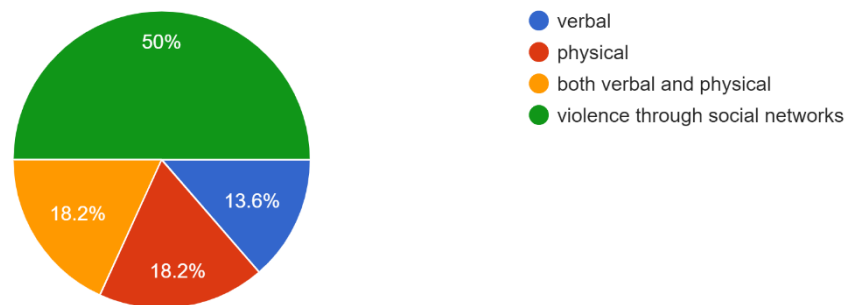

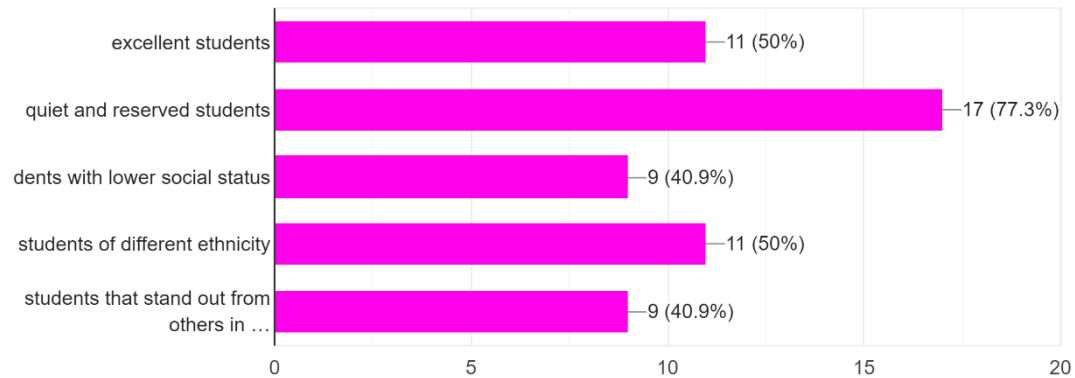

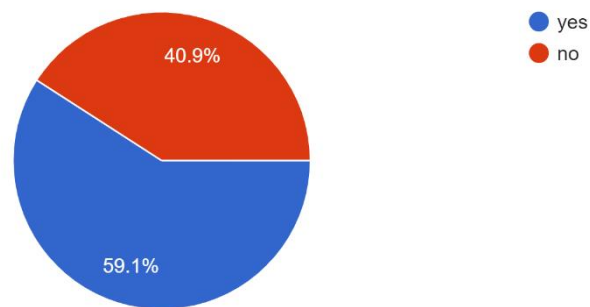

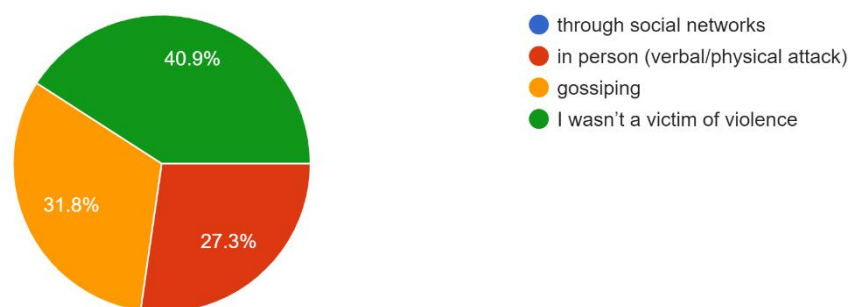

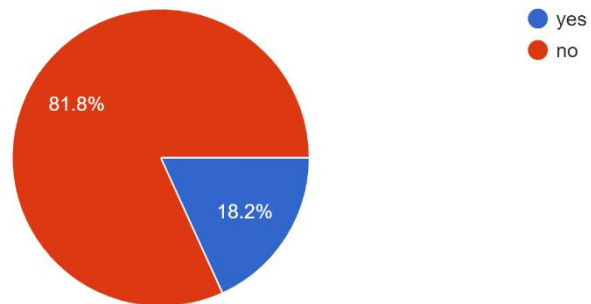

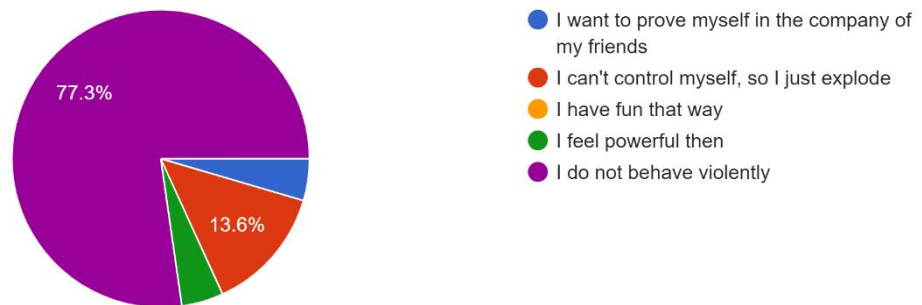

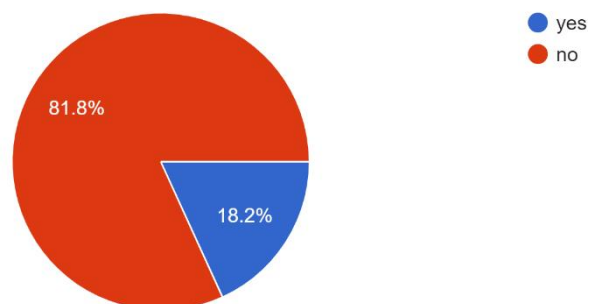
14. The reason for your violent behaviour is:

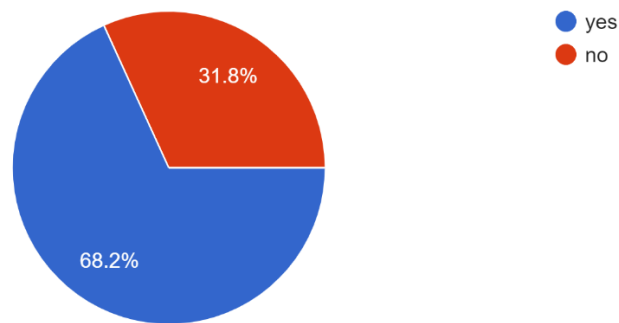

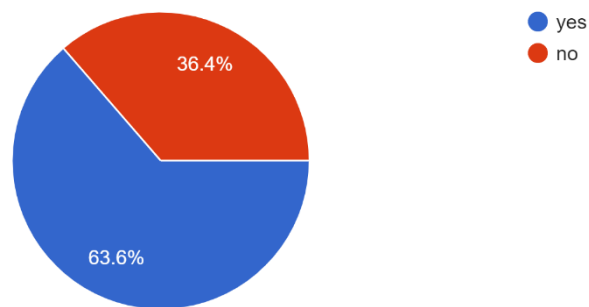
